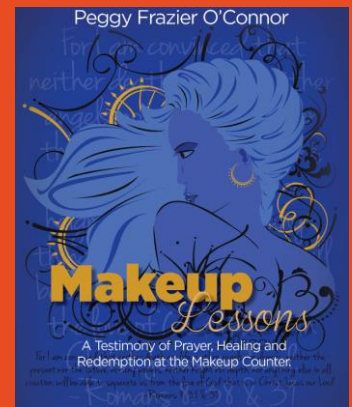

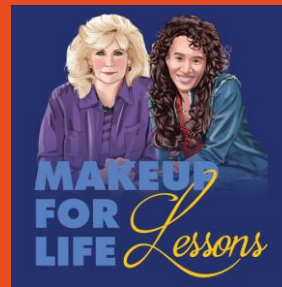

I had a choice at an early age and managed to count my blessings rather than heartaches. As a child who grew up in foster care in New York City, I had low self-esteem and wondered who am I? Who are my parents? and who is ever going to love me? Nevertheless, God must have had His hand on my shoulder and inspired me to be grateful for what I did have rather than what I didn't have. I didn't know that in the book of Ephesians in the Bible, it tells us "I'm accepted in the beloved" and that "I'm perfectly and wonderfully made." It wasn't until much later in life that I learned I wasn't alone and that Our Lord was hearing my every word and drying every tear. I've learned that tears are like rain. 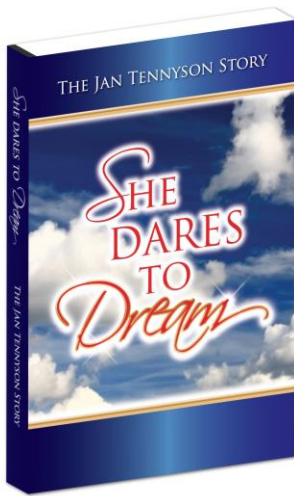

Make “Spot On” part of your daily briefing from Alexa.

Do you have an Alexa voice assistant? If you do, you can add “Spot On With the Word” part of your daily briefing.

Go to your Alexa app on your phone. Select Settings, then select “Flash Briefing” under Alexa Preferences.

Then select the “Add Content” link, which will enable you to search for the Alexa Skill you want to add. When you type in just “Spot On” and search, you will the Spot On Alexa skill at the top of the list. Select this skill to add it to your flash briefing.

If you have other skills that are part of your flash briefing, you can get select the Edit button in the upper right corner to arrange the skills in the order you desire.
